

**City Council Meeting – Special Meeting – April 12, 2017**

Mayor Jeremy Menning called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at Hartford City Hall with the following city council members present: Mark Monahan, Arden Jones, Mark Brenneman, Travis Kuehl, Ryan Horn and Scott Nelson. City Administrator Teresa Sidel was also present.

**Approve Agenda:** A motion was made by Horn, second by Jones to approve the agenda as set - all voted yes, motion carried.

**Discussion of Grass/Tree Branch Dump Site:** At the April 4, 2017 City Council meeting, a motion was made to move the city grass/tree branch dump site to the 5 acres of city property north of town along county highway 130. Since that time, we have received information that a conditional use permit must be secured from the county before we can proceed with this site. The Hartford Governing Board gathered to discuss option for moving forward with this dump site location and the timeline involved. Terry Hagen and Brian Voth attended the meeting and gave their input on the subject. A motion was made by Monahan, second by Brenneman, to open the current grass/tree branch dump site along Railroad Street as soon as staff can get it ready under the same regulations – the site will be open 7 days a week, unfenced and unmanned – in the meantime, the city will pursue a conditional use permit with Minnehaha County to allow a grass/tree branch dump site on the 5 acres of city property north of town – Kuehl voted no, with all others voting yes, motion carried.

**Adjournment:** A motion was made by Brenneman, second by Nelson to adjourn at 7:38 p.m. – all voted yes, motion carried.
