

City Council Meeting – Special Meeting June 28, 2021

Mayor Jeremy Menning called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m. with the following city council members present: Mark Monahan, Arden Jones, Mark Brenneman, LaVonne Randall, Travis Kuehl, and Mark O’Hara. City Administrator Teresa Sidel, Public Works Superintendent Craig Wagner, and Chamber and Economic Development Director Amy Farr were also present. David Doxtad, Rachel Kloss, Steve Watson, Michael Redenbaugh and Lisha Wu were present from ISG, along with one member of the public.

Approve Agenda: A motion was made by Jones, second by Randall to approve the agenda as set – all voted yes, motion carried.

Review/Discuss of WWTF Information and Options for Feasibility Study: Members of ISG’s team were present to discuss the city’s feasibility study for the future Wastewater Treatment Facility. Items discussed included location, treatment technology, size and regionalization, and costs figures and funding opportunities. The feasibility study has identified 2 parcels of land for the future WWTF – the current lagoon land or the city parcel owned by 190 Exit 390. Both parcels were evaluated to handle 4 different scenarios for wastewater treatment. Each scenario allowed the city to build on and expand for future growth or regionalization. After review of each scenario at both sites, it was the consensus of the city council to pursue options for the land by Exit 390. ISG will be completing the feasibility study and then present a final report to the city council.
