

ORDINANCE #672

SPEED RESTRICTIONS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HARTFORD, SOUTH DAKOTA, AMENDING TITLE 7 CHAPTER 7.03 SPEED RESTRICTIONS SECTION 7.0303 MAXIMUM LIMITS GENERALLY,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HARTFORD, SOUTH DAKOTA:

THAT TITLE 7, CHAPTER 7.3, SECTION 7.0303 BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Maximum Limits Generally. Except as may otherwise be provided by the City Council, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive any vehicle at a rate of speed greater than the following:

- A. Twenty (20) miles per hour within any residential district unless otherwise stated below or posted.
- B. Fifteen (15) miles per hour on Main Street from South Street to the north side of Century Square and Twenty (20) miles per hour within any other business district.
- C. Fifteen (15) miles per hour on Vandemark Avenue from Second Street to David Roe Drive
- D. Fifteen (15) miles per hour on David Roe Drive.
- E. Thirty (30) miles per hour on Vandemark Avenue 350 feet north from Par Tee Drive.
- F. Thirty (30) miles per hour on Mickelson Road.
- G. Forty (40) miles per hour on Western Avenue north of Mickelson Road.
- H. Forty-Five (45) miles per hour on Western Avenue south of Mickelson Road.
- I. The appropriate legal maximums established by state law on all other county or state road or highway within the City shall be effective.
